











# **Graduation Rate (2016): Disaggregated**

4-Year Cohort Method – Five-County Region















## Post-Secondary Enrollment: Disaggregated

% of 2013 Graduating Class That Enrolled in a Post-Secondary Institution after 16 months – Five-County Region













## Post-Secondary Persistence: Disaggregated

% of 2012 Graduating Class That Enrolled in a Post-Secondary Institution after 16 months who then completed one year of credits within 24 months — Five-County Region




