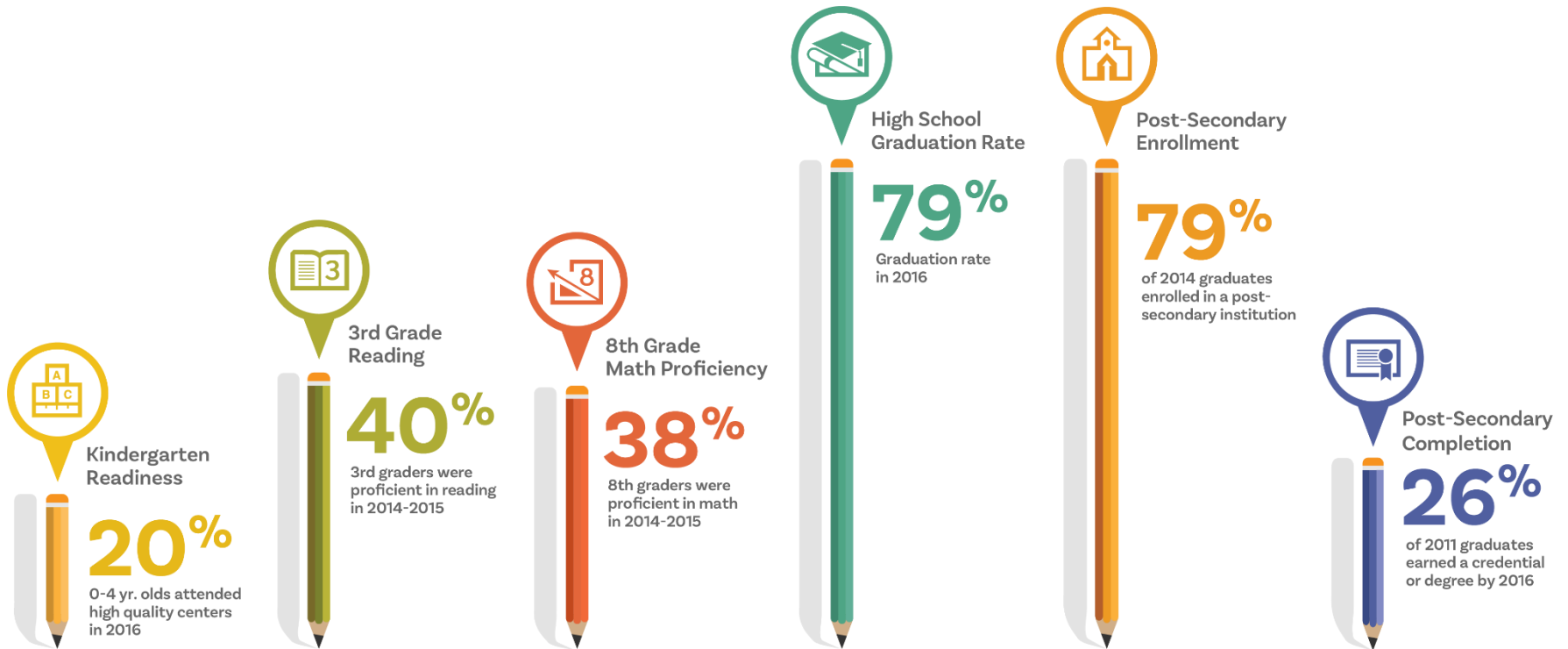

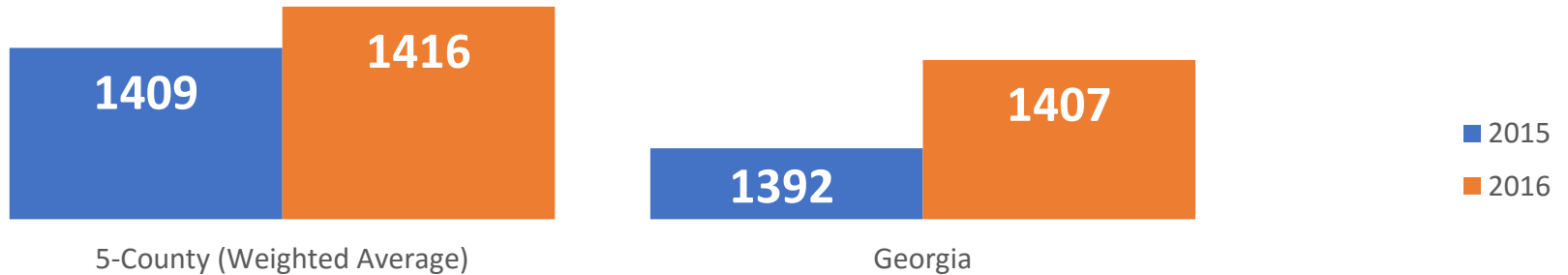

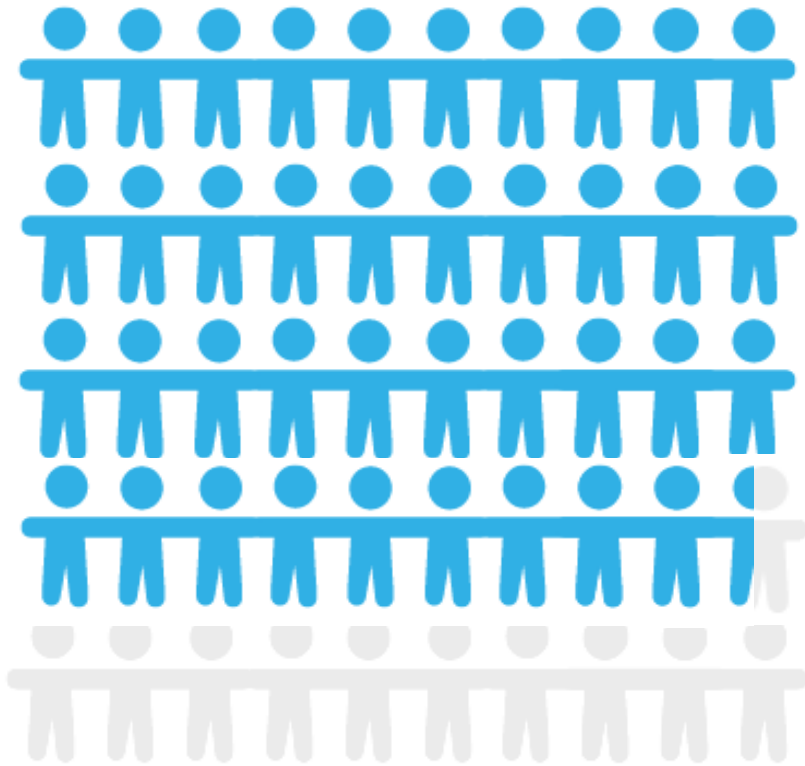
Average SAT Scores – 2015, 2016

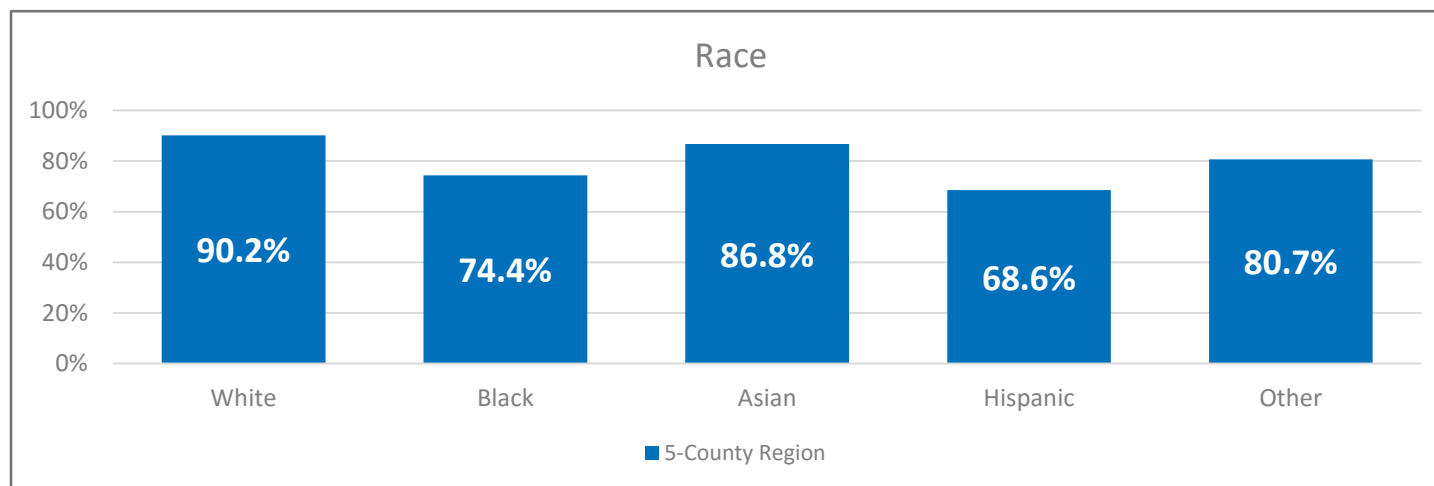

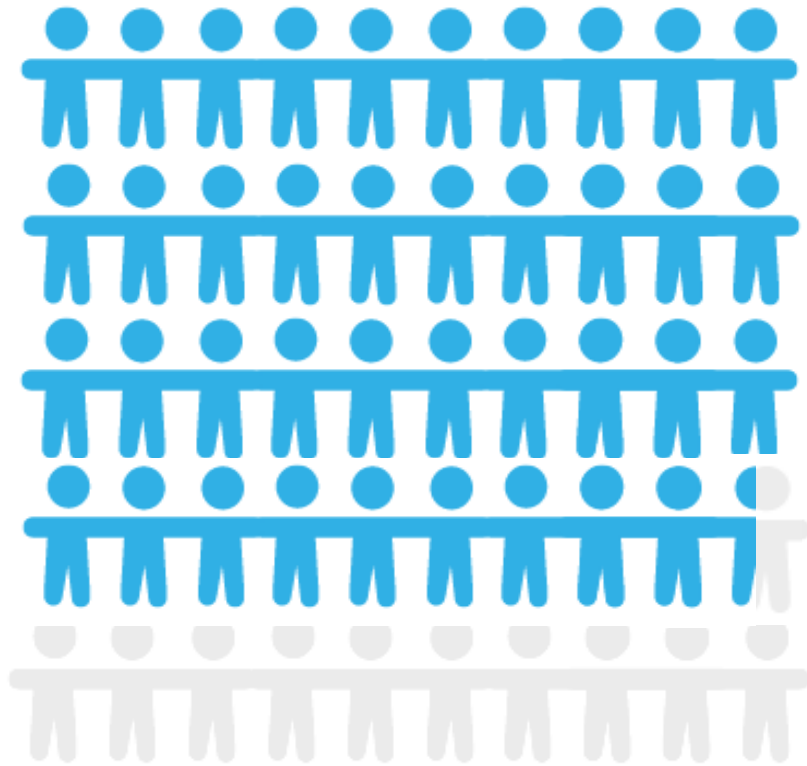

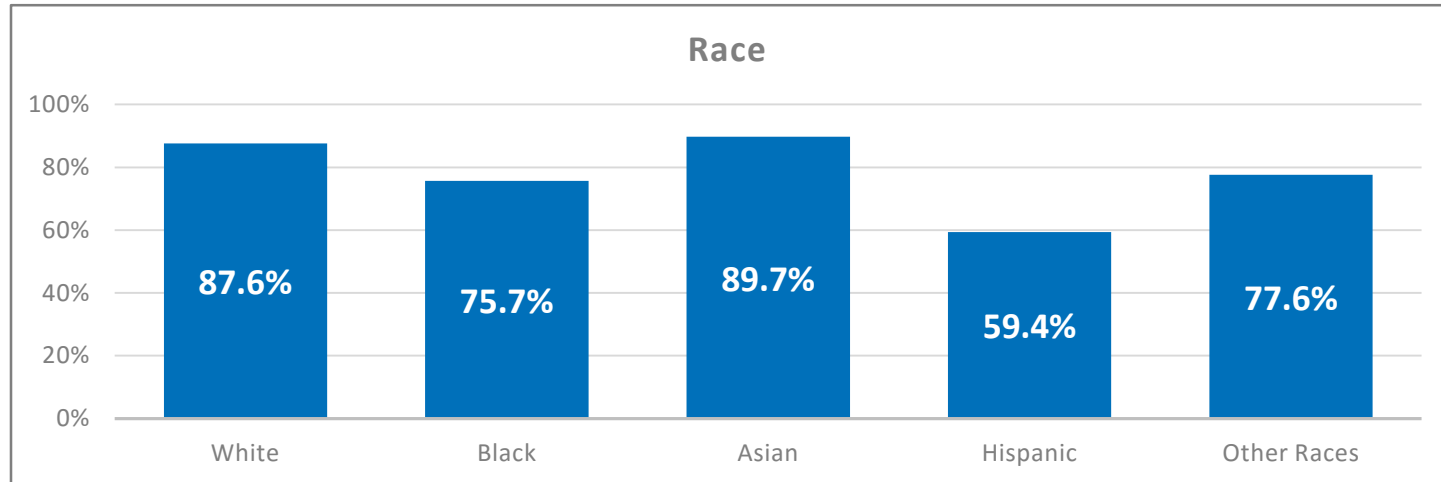

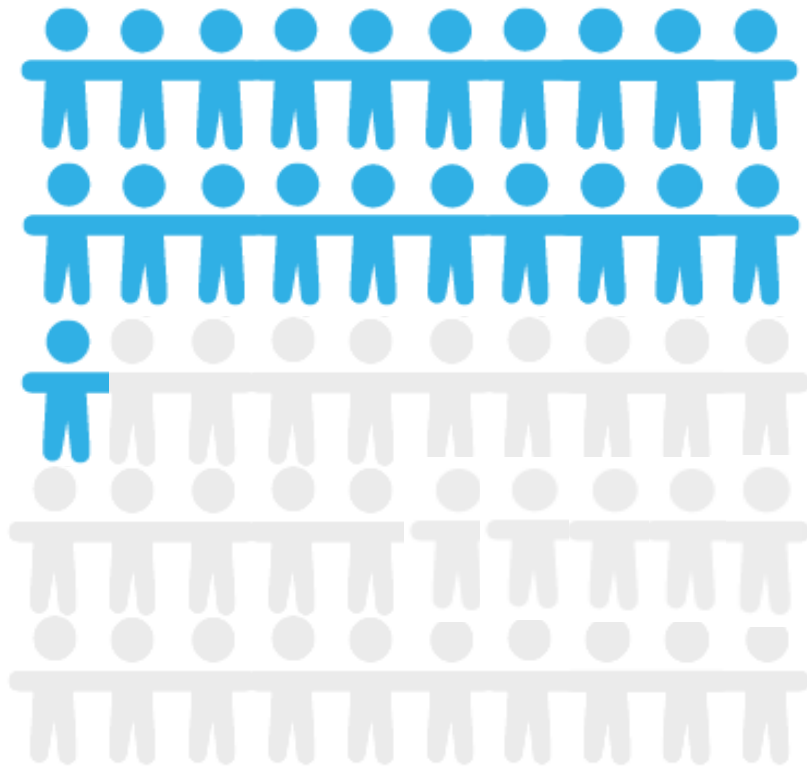
Post-Secondary Enrollment: Disaggregated

42% of the 2012 graduating class who enrolled in a post-secondary institution persisted to earn a 1 year of credit after 24 months in college

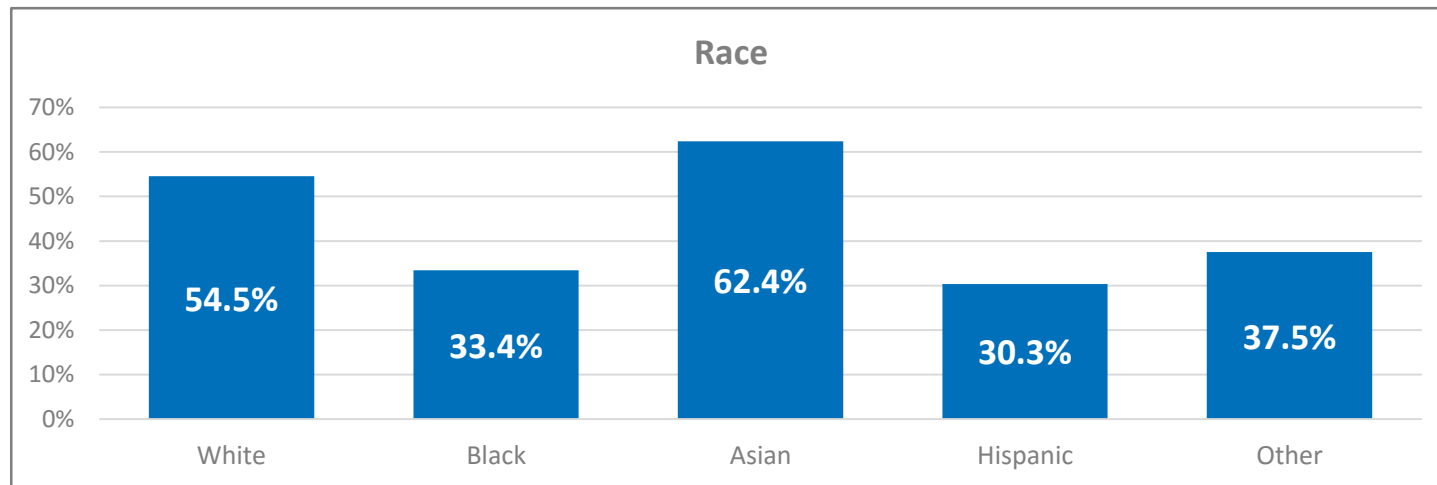
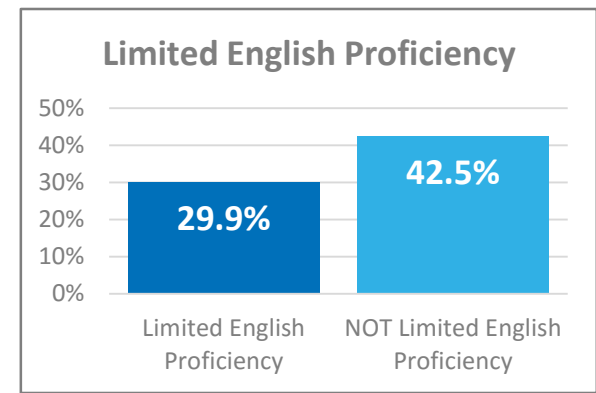
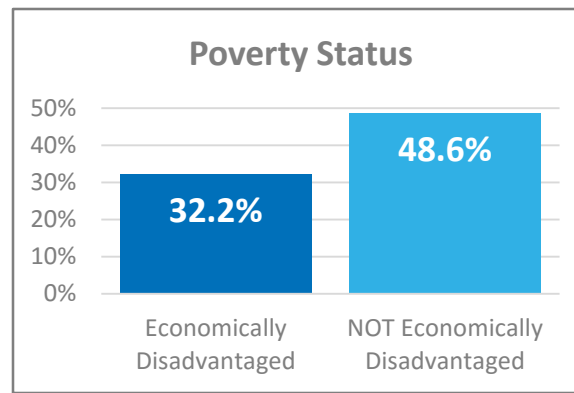
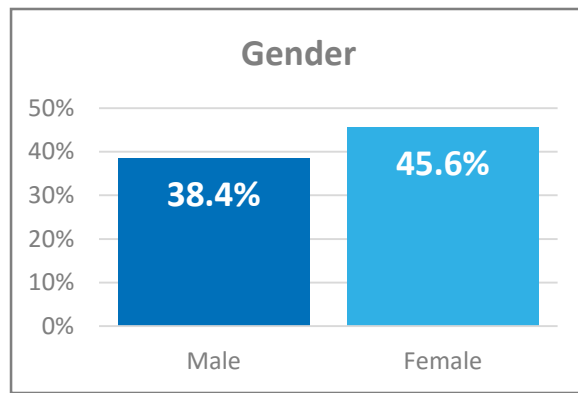

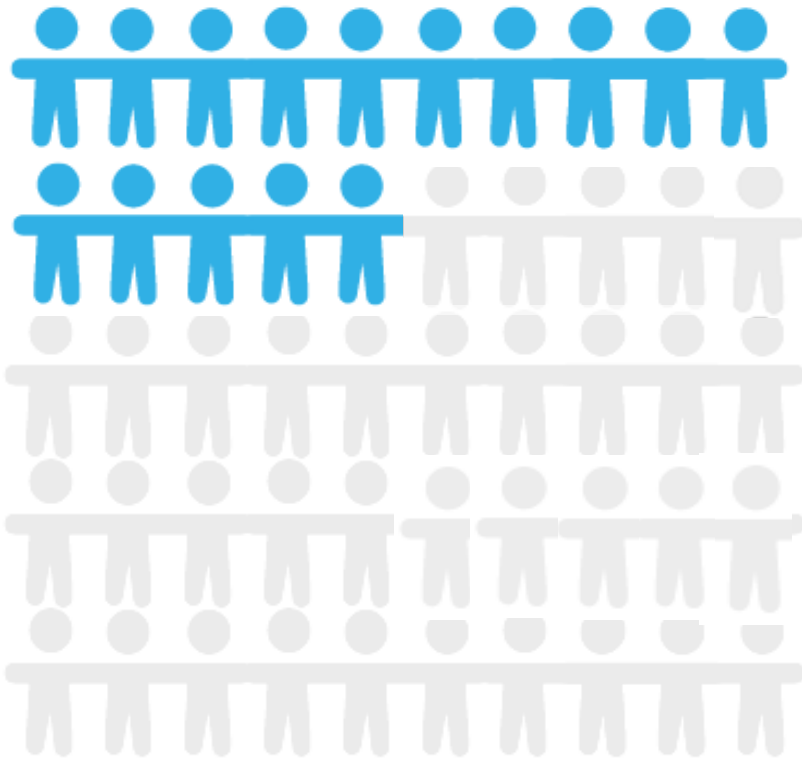
Post-Secondary Persistence: Disaggregated
